Report on World Youth Meeting 2011 Nihon Fukushi University Rina Yada

WYM 2011

This year was my third time participating World Youth Meeting and I was a presenter again. I also did presenter two years ago, but last time, I did not collaborate with any other foreign student. This year, I experienced collaborating with a student from the Philippines.

Preparation period

Our preparation for the presentation started from May. There were three NFU members including me, from freshman to junior. At first, I was not sure how I should get involved with the group members because originally, WYM was hosted by freshman and sophomore students. I asked other junior students who were also participating WYM as a presenter, but each junior students' position differed from group to group. Some junior students took the leadership of the group, but on the other hand, some groups were taken control by sophomore students. When our group members gathered, I thought I didn't need to worry about this issue anymore. Sophomore student in my group naturally took the leadership and I thought that is how WYM should be; sophomore students take the leadership.

We never had any trouble building a good relationship, but we could not promote the discussion since we often got off the track. This led our presentation to complete three days before presenting. Meeting with the Philippines student, we faced another trouble which made the already complicated situation more complicated.

Our remaining presentation member from the Philippines arrived six days before our presentation. When we had discussion about our presentation for the first time, we realized that there was difference in understanding the presentation theme between NFU students and the Philippines student. We tried to put those different concepts together into one presentation, but we couldn't come up with any good idea so we asked the professor for help as soon as possible. The professor gave us some advice and we liked it. So I told the Philippines student the idea the professor have told us. She

agreed as well so we started working with that idea. I realized that it is very important to ask for other people's advice when thinking about the presentation theme.

Seminar for the presentation

This year, we had three days and two nights seminar for the presenters so we can concentrate on preparing our



presentation. I liked this idea very much because we had a lot of time to communicate with foreign students and with also the presentation members. We were able to build good relationships here. And of course, we were able to concentrate more on making presentation than at school. Our members were able to spend a lot more time together comparing with the past WYM.

During this seminar, I saw many other presentation groups working hard to make great presentations. This made me feel from the bottom of my heart that all the presentation groups will succeed.

The Day of Presentation

As I know other presentation groups which included NFU students working hard from the seminar, I felt very anxious while watching presentations even though it was not my turn. Many other students said the same thing. At this point, I found another advantage of having seminar for the presenters. We can understand more about how hard other presentation groups worked for. When each presentation ended we praised each other.



Our presentation was on the second day. We finished making our script two days before that day. Since we didn't have so much time left, I translated most of the Japanese script into English. I think this made other members hard to memorize the script. This may have led them to more nervousness, but it turned out to be good presentation. We did our best although we were running out of time.

Conclusion

From my experience and feedback, I thought when making up things together, we need to talk over and over to make sure that we really have the same concept and when you get stuck, you should ask other people for some advice or idea. In the process of making the presentation, we can brush up our ability to communicate both in English and Japanese. In my opinion, we succeeded in building good relationship through the seminar this year and that led the entire presentation groups to perform well.

Communication skills

Summary: This year's theme is "21st century skills ~How can we make use of social connectibility~" All of the students learned four outcomes. These are Cross-Cultural Understanding, Usage of ICT (Information Communication Technology), English Language Education, Planning and Implementation of International Exchanges.



Collaborative Presentation

In fact, we had some trouble making presentation. I was a little confused because of the dilemma we encountered. At that time, an idea suddenly occurred to me. This idea was that if I listened to my friend's concerns, this would help to solve the problem. However, I found that nothing necessarily came about from our attempts to compromise. I suggested to her that she should tell our leader. As a result, our presentation did not change a great deal but I thought her face looked satisfied after expressing her own opinion. I believe that this kind of expression is vital to the creation of a strong team and by extension, necessary for communication in globalization practices.

Mihama Seminar for Presentation

The theme of our presentation was how to tackle the problem of creating a good presentation in a short amount of time. I was sure that this issue was one of the most important things for our team to consider. I learned about how to do this from Dr. Igarashi and Dr. Yoshida's seminar. As a result, I now know that I must keep three things in mind when I make a presentation. First of all, according to Dr. Yoshida and Dr. Igarashi, there are three purposes presentation, which are to inform, to persuade and to entertain. These are important for us to capture the listener's attention. Next, one must bear in mind the concept of the six Cs, that is, to be concise, clear, concrete considers, consistent, to speak with conviction and to establish a connection. In doing so, the speaker is therefore able to fully comprehend the listener's viewpoint. Finally, Dr. Igarashi and Dr. Yoshida also mentioned the win-win relationship. Presentations are not deigned to decide on priority to speak. Rather, making a presentation is about cooperating with each other and therefore, showing our concern for others. Also, if we avoid each other a presentation, or in other words, fail to establish mutual collaboration in a group, we will not have to face to conflict. Disagreements are sometimes necessary and especially healthy to the creation of a strong and persuasive presentation to collaborate. This therefore leads to a relationship of win-win. After listening to Dr. Igarashi and Dr. Yoshida's seminar on presentations, overall, that making a good, earned presentation is essentially to start to understand one another and to share with others.

Taiwan Students and Our Sightseeing Excursion

On the 9th and 10th of August, Joanna and Jenny, who came from Taiwan, and I went to Kyoto. At first, we went toward Kinkaku temple and Kiyomizu temple. After we arrived, we took many pictures, ate some food walked around. I was surprised that Joanna knew more about Japanese history than me. I thought I should study about japan more. When we talked, sometimes we could not understand each other because of a lack of English vocabulary. However, we did not give up communicating. Whenever I was aware, we spoke three languages which were Japanese, Taiwanese and English in our conversation. Outcomes from 3 years of experiences at the World Youth Meeting

Various viewpoints

I could learn several things from my experiences at WYM over two years This year, I played the role of supervisor and in the presentation section. I discovered structures the inner working of WYM organization that I've never known.

This time, I will clarify these experiences.

The facilitation skills of a supervisor

I was a supervisor for managing the project. By utilizing a process map and the Nihon Fukushi University SNS site, named FUXI, we grasped the progress situation and could share the problems.

From this experience, I would like to clarity what is needed to manage a team.

To observe from the local point of view



When you instruct team members about the ways of working, most supervisors tend to think only from their own point of view. To do proper instruct, it requires an objective idea. By observing the local point of view, the team motivation will rise.

Management of the collaborative presentation preparation

In the WYM, there are many opportunities to do presentations with overseas students. It requires English communication. However, a lot of students might feel their poor English is a wall preventing clear communication. As a result, the contents of the discussions might be shallow. But I think the problem was not the English communication. Then, how can people communicate well? And how can they make an effective presentation?

Basic communication

· to know each other

Even if counterparts are not overseas students, communication will not start without understanding each other. Having a positive attitude towards friends more and more is significant.

• To give ones opinion

When we talked about the theme, there were many students who hardly expressed any opinion. Most of the students were trying to avoid conflict.

First of all, it is important to talk. It is important to ask questions even about small problems. By discussing the problems, some conflict may arise. But this may help make good changes. We could easily predict the process including the conflicts that makes the contents nicer one.

Presentation preparation

Problem discovery

In order to make an effective presentation for an audience, we need to be able to observe from a variety of viewpoints about the theme, the questionnaire, and the literature. Thereby, new subjects and ideas are discovered.

• Theoretical

To get an audience's satisfaction, we need to be able to improve our theory. For this purpose, we have to analyze and investigate the subject carefully. It makes the original idea better.

From these experiences, we came to believe strongly that basic skills are more important while learning ICT, International collaboration and presentation.

I came to understand that these skills are based on fundamental competencies.

Reflective comments from Waseda Honjo 2011 participants

Comments from the 6 new participants (the 1st- and 2nd- year students)

There were three reasons I decided to take part in the WYM. First, I wanted to see how well I could use English and to gain experience of speaking with people from abroad. Second, I wanted to give a serious, genuine presentation. Third, I wanted to improve my ability to use the ICT. The seniors of my team were good at using the ICT, and I wanted to be a good user like them.

Waseda team started preparation by brainstorming sessions on the theme -- the 21st century skills and how to use the connectibility. We also wanted to make our presentation relevant to the Free Paper Project, and that became one of the discussion topics. The intensive preparation started after the final exam of the 1st term. We met afterschool on Wednesdays and Saturdays. When the summer vacation started, we came to school 5 times a week, and had on-line chat sessions in the midnight. It was difficult to decide the topic and approach of our presentation, collaborating with our Indonesian partners. Until we came up with our definition of "the 21st century skills" and "the bonds," we talked and talked and talked. Thanks to our seniors' advice, we finally reached to the topic of our presentation. By the time we went to Aichi, we had started making the PowerPoint slides in English.

To prepare for our presentation, we started to Aichi on August 3, six days before the WYM. On the first day in Aichi, we met Tiwi and Linda, our Indonesian partners for the first time. We felt like we had met them before, because we had corresponded with each other using Facebook. We worked all day and night, even after dinner at the hotel. It was tough.

On the first day of the WYM, we listened to presentations given by other high school and college students. We were surprised at the levels of them -- they were very high! We were anxious about our presentation we were going to give the next day. When all the presentations of Day One were over, we distributed our FP to the audience.

When our turn came on the next day, we were very nervous. It was our first time to give a presentation in front of that many people. But we did it! Our effort "fruited" and we felt a sense of accomplishment. Also, we realized that learning different cultures is important, and now we want to improve our English more.

What is more, we learned a lot from our seniors. Seeing them working very hard even when they were tired, we felt we had to work harder. We learned that the important thing is not only English

skills but also an ability to use the ICT and an ability to bring the team mates together. Through this experience, we learned A LOT of things. We want to make full use of this experience to improve ourselves.

Comments from the 2 repeaters (the 3rd-year students)

It was my second chance to take part in WYM. Last year, I was one of presenter. And it was so hard for me that I couldn't do except doing presentation. This year, I took part in as a manager and clicker. And because of the 2nd experience, I was able to look at the surroundings as well as target jobs. I felt there were more groups which made good moods than last year.

After this contest, I wanted to do presentation one more time in this stage so as to know my progress through this two years.

Thank you for giving me precious time.

The presentation we made for the WYM 2011 is much worth to me because we could find some solutions to the problems we had had for a long time. The problem was "how to keep in touch with others through the Internet." We had many bitter experiences in online interaction during preparations for the WYM 2010 and the Free Paper Project (creating a free magazine through Yogya-Waseda collaboration). Learning from the past failures, we tried using different ICT tools time to time, depending on the purposes of interaction. This new practices worked better, and Waseda members could work much closer with our Indonesian partners. I am sure that this experience will help me in the future, when I need to work closely with people using the ICT.
