振りかえって

今回の WYM の活動から反省点、良かった点、気付いた点が挙げられる。そして、それらの点を通し学べたことがいくつかある。

まず、反省点として挙げることはペアの学生との英語力の差である。WYM 本番までにプレ ゼンテーションを作りあげるため数回ペアの学生とオンライン会議を開いた。しかし、そ のときに自分の英語力の低さから相手の学生が言っている意味が理解出来ず、上手く意思 疎通が出来ないこととペアの学生は私が理解していないことを把握し伝えたいことを何回 も説明してくれることが何度かあった。また、会議をするときに私が言いたいことはこの 英語であっているのかという不安から話し出せないときが多くあった。これは自分自身の 語彙力や知識量を増やすことも大事だと思うが、相手が言っている意味が理解出来ない、 自分の伝えたいことを英語でどのように表現すれば分からないとしても積極的に意思疎通 を取ろうとする姿勢が大事だと考えた。

プレゼンテーション

次に挙げる反省点は、プレゼンテーションのやり方である。私達のグループは、本番ま でにペアの学生とオンライン会議を開きプレゼンテーションをする練習はした。しかし、 本番になると緊張してしまい、相手に伝えようとするのではなく自分が担当するスライド を読むということだけに集中してしまった。実際に、自分達の本番のプレゼンテーション の録画を見返すと話し方にあまり抑揚がないように感じ、ただ原稿を読んでいるという風 に感じた。そのため、本番だけでなく練習の時点から自分がプレゼンテーションをしてい る様子を録画し自分自身でどのように話しているか知り、確認することをするべきだと思 った。

言語の働き

良かった点と気付いた点として挙げることは、普段使っている言語が違ったとしても英語という1つの言語を使用することでコミュニケーションが取れ、同じ課題に向けて私達は活動が出来ることだ。私はペアがフィリピンの学生でゴール5のジェンダー平等についてプレゼンテーションをした。プレゼンテーションを作り上げるためにペアの学生とフィリピンと日本でどのような課題があるかを話し合った。そのとき、フィリピンの学生が日本の課題について SNS やインターネットの情報から日本の政治家がこのようなことを言っていたなど直近の情報でも調べて知っていた。そしてそのことについて、実際に日本に住んでいる私の意見や他の国から見た意見など様々な意見交換をすることが出来た。このように、WYM の活動を通して、国関係なく今起こっている問題について話し合うことが出来た。

発表スライド

WYM を通しパワーポイントの作り方次第で相手への伝わり方が違うということを学べた。 日曜日に開催されたセミナーでパワーポイントのスライドには重要な言葉だけをのせ写真 を中心にした方が良いということは学んでいたが、実際に WYM で他の学校のパワーポイン トを見てその大事さがよく分かった。文字を中心的に作っているスライドと絵や写真を中 心的に作っているスライドでは絵や写真を中心的に作っているものの方が情報としてよく 入ってきた。自分パワーポイントを作るときは自分が何を伝えたいかもう分かっているた め文字が多くても違和感がないように感じる。しかし、自分がプレゼンテーションをする 相手は全く何を伝えたいか知らないということを頭に必ずいれパワーポイントを作らなけ ればいけないと思った。

今回の WYM を通して英語の能力やパワーポイントの作り方など様々な反省点や気付きを 学ぶことが出来た。この学び得られたものをこれからの大学生活や海外の人と活動すると きなどに活用していきたい。

1 参加目的

1. 参加した目的・動機

5. この経験から学んだこと

カンボジアの教育について調べるとともに日本の教育問題についても調べることができ ました。カンボジアの教員、教材不足が基本的なテーマでしたが、調べていくと日本の小 学校英語教育でも同じ問題があることがわかりました。国ごとの教育問題を比較する良い 機会になりました。

Purpose of participation

1. The purpose of our participation in WYM is to acquire the ability to face the problems that occur in the world and to try to solve them from multiple perspectives. What we learned from WYM2021

What we need to improve

1.It was difficult to get a sense of each other's feelings because we were talking with the camera off when we were meeting in zoom.

2. Too much time was spent in the preparation stage and there were not enough times to rehearse.

3.It was difficult to deepen friendships through zooming, and individuals tended to communicate their questions and opinions to the leader rather than to the line group. Therefore, I feel that it was a heavy burden on the leader.

4. There were many evening meetings, and sometimes the students were too busy or too tired to participate. So, I think it would have been better to be flexible with the meeting times.

Looking-back on the WYM2021

Purpose of participation

 We wanted to experience once again the sense of accomplishment of completing a presentation in the field of SDGs in which we are interested through international collaboration. In addition, WYM2021 was the culmination of the international presentation events for us, and as it was the last opportunity of our student life, so we decided to participate, hoping to receive a Platinum Award.

What we learned from WYM2021

- 1. We need to be clear about the time and agenda of our meetings. According to our reflections on last year's WYM2020, "When we had a meeting, we should have decided on a goal for the meeting. When we did not, our discussion was abstract, and time was just passing by." This time, thanks to the cooperation of the teachers from the other school, we felt that there were a lot of active meetings where it was clear what was to be discussed today and what needed to be done by the next meeting.
- 2. We also learned the importance of sharing information with the other team's leader and members behind the meeting. This way, we can understand each other's thoughts and ideas outside of the meeting. Also, I felt that by thinking about the agenda beforehand, the meeting will go more smoothly and efficiently. We are a little disappointed that we could not win a Platinum Award, but we would like to use these skills what we learned from this precious experience.

What we need to improve

- 1. It would have been better to start with a clear direction (conclusion) for the presentation because in the process of making it, we lost track of what we wanted to tell the audience about.
- 2. We spoke too fast because we packed too much information into our presentation.
- 3. We should have thought about what to do and what to talk if we didn't get any questions in the Q and A session.
- 4. In Japan side, we regret that we left a lot of the work to the Taiwanese side. They created the framework and PowerPoint for the presentation, so we should have used Google Drive and other tools to share the work efficiently.

WYM2021 Reflection Ritsumeikan Junior and Senior High School

今回のWYMでは、うまくいった点と反省点の両方が挙げられます。まず、うまくいった点はプレ ゼンテーションの重視すべきポイントを意識して取り組むことができた点です。例えば、5月行われ

た RitsBattle(立命館高校で行われたディベート大会)のようなディスカッションの場においては、自 分の意見を主張すること自体にフォーカスされますが、今回のようなプレゼンテーションの場では、 それに加えてどれだけ効果的に聞き手に主張を伝えられるかにも焦点が当てられます。そのため、 いくら内容が良くても伝え方が悪ければ評価されないということです。それに伴い、私たちには話し 方を工夫する必要が生じました。具体的に言うと、抑揚や英語らしい発音などです。それが私にと って、今回のWYMにおける最初の難関でした。私のこれまでの英語学習では、主に「読む」「書く」 「聴く」の三点に注力しており、発音や英語のリズムの練習をした経験が乏しかったからです。しか し、今回のディスカッションビデオを制作するにあたり、自分の声を録音してアフレコしなければなら ず、いざ録音してみると自分でさえ聞き取れないようなひどい発音をしている箇所が多くありました。 その結果、自分のセリフのパートを納得できる状態で録音するのに3時間もかかってしまうという事 態に陥りました。最終的には、その甲斐もあってか私たちのグループのビデオは好評だったようで、 賞を獲得できたため、3時間は無駄ではなかったと思います。また、このビデオ制作で発音の重要

性に気づいたことで、プレゼンテーションの方でも話し方の工夫をすることができました。そのため、

これはうまくいった点であると言えます。ですが、私はこの経験を通じて自分の発音を強化する必要があると痛感しました。これからは、自分の声を録音したり、単語を学ぶときにはスマートフォンの ソフトを使うなどして正しい発音やアクセント、熟語の時はどちらを強調するのかなどを確認したりす る必要があると思います。次に反省すべき点です。

今回のWYMでのパートナーは台湾の高雄女子高校の生徒たちで、小さなアクシデントや不具 合がありましたが、スムーズに準備を整えることができていたように思います。ですが、海外生がリー ドしてくれることへの甘えが生じ、自分たちの意見をプレゼンテーションの内容に反映させることが あまりできておらず、アクションプランのスクリプト制作も海外生に任せてしまった手前、疑問を感じ ても逐一指摘することが難しくなってしまいました。ですが、意見を出さないようではそこにいないも 同然です。そのため、もっと積極的に議論に参加して自分たちと海外生との共通認識を確認したり、 均衡点を探ったりする努力をするべきだったと思います。それができなかった原因は積極性や英 語力の差だけではなく、やはり思考レベルの差にあると考えられ、今の日本の教育では海外に勝 てないと言うことを感じさせられた、というのが率直な感想です。日本は海外と比較すると議論をす る機会が少ないと言われる国で、私自身も義務教育の過程で議論をしたことなど数えるほどしかあ りません。そのため、海外生と対等に議論するのが難しく、結果的に今回のような事態を招くに至っ たのではないかと考えます。では、どうすれば良いのか。まずは意見を持つこと、そのためのリサー チを徹底することが大前提だと思います。今回私たちが扱ったテーマは高齢化社会でした。この場 合、リサーチは高齢化社会の原因やメカニズムだけでなく、それによる損害、各国が行っている政 策にまで及ぶ必要があります。これにより、アクションプランを考えやすくなったり、既にある案とか ぶることを防いだりできるからです。それができて初めて、相手の意見と戦わせたり折衷案を模索し たりということが可能になります。今回のWYMを通して、私が発見した課題は以下の2つです。 1. 英語の発音、リズムの改善 2. 議論の力の向上

However, I really liked each online meetings planned with Taiwanese students, and I noticed the significance of having a bond with people in abroad under the COVID's circumstance to cooperate to make the world better and to terminate the pandemic.

I realized the importance of that "we", people living in this moment and this era especially teenagers like me, must take actions for making a sustainable and a comfortable world to pass down to the next generation. To do so, I thought that it's necessary to have discussion with people all over the world, despite the obstacles caused by pandemics. Though the time I had for working with a project with Taiwanese students was short, I felt it interesting to hear the measurements that their government has been setting, in short, it's usual for people in Taiwan that no plastic cutleries are distributed at stores to decrease the amount of plastic waste.

Also, the most surprising fact for me during the talk with the Taiwan side was that more Taiwanese students know about "green hotel" which doesn't provide any single use of amenities compared to Japanese students. For me, it was the first time to hear the name and its concept at that time. Like this example, it was a great experience hearing the daily life of Taiwanese students and any special eco-friend measurements being done in Taiwan. Even I couldn't meet them in person, I think this is a meaningful opportunity that I could meet them through devices and reached our own solution which is to promote green hotel in both in Japan and in Taiwan on the website we made, by sharing what we individually and usually see, feel, and think, and compare them. After the final presentation, I felt the feeling of accomplishment which I've never gained before. Because I joined WYM, I was able to meet with the Taiwanese students and we were able to encourage and cooperate to create our best work. I'm so happy that I got new friends in Taiwan and more and more excitement of going to Taiwan after pandemic is in my mind now. In conclusion, I found it so much fun of exchanging the ideas of global issues crossing the borders and working on one project by having online meetings. WYM of this year is ended, but I'll keep in touch with my Taiwanese friends, and I want to cherish this new friendship. Moreover, I'll cherish each moment of the present, and join such online events positively.

1. 作業での問題点

1. 台湾の生徒たちとの交流

今回のWYMではパートナーの台湾の学校とLINEでやり取りを行った。コロナ禍で対面 での交流ができない中、実際に会ったこともない相手との交流には正直戸惑いがあった が、少しずつ本番に向けての準備を進めた。そして、このような状況下でも台湾の生徒た ちが積極的にコンタクトを試みてくれたので大きな刺激を受けた。
